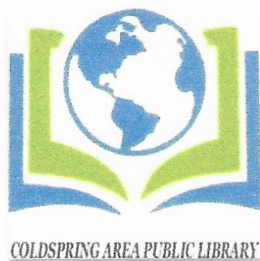


# The Coldspring Area Public Library

CAPL is accredited by the Texas State Library and Archive Commission. Libraries that are accredited are eligible for certain services from the Texas State Library – TexShare databases, TexShare card, Inter-Library Loan program, E-rate discounts, competitive grants, and additional programs as offered by the State Library.

CAPL has between 13,000 and 15,000 volumes on the shelves. The librarian continuously orders new volumes and discards out of date volumes to keep our selections relative to the needs of the community. Our librarian, assistant librarian and library aide operate the library 6 days a week with the assistance of more than 10 volunteers.

Patrons may check out books locally, but also have access to statewide interlibrary loans and e-books through the Piney Woods Digital Consortium. Other services provided include a free computer lab and Wi-Fi service. For a nominal fee we provide copying, faxing, scanning, and a notary service.

CAPL is independently operated. We depend on grants, fundraisers and individual donations.
